#### - Gross Motor Skills:

Throwing & catching, sending & receiving balls, dancing, exploring ways to link movements together, action games.

#### - Fine Motor Skills:

Mark making using a range of equipment, developing pincer grip, using tools safely, eg scissors, peg boards, hammers, knives, forks.

#### **Maths**

#### - Numbers

Building numbers to 20, making patterns to 20. Verbal counting to 20 & beyond, adding & subtracting, sharing and grouping and exploring odd and even numbers

- Shape, Space & Measures
Rotating, manipulating and composing shapes.

# **Communication and Language**

## - Speaking

Communicating with adults, & peers; use questions to find out. Use new vocabulary and comment on what they've heard.

# - Listening, Attention and Understanding.

Develop listening skills from following instructions, listening to and discussions. Listen to new and familiar rhymes, stories and poems

# **Understanding the World**

#### - Past & Present

Learn about the past from local walks, favourite stories, nursery rhymes.

# - People, Culture & Communities Explore & celebrate festivals e.g., Spring, May Day.

#### -The Natural World

Make observations of the natural world, e.g., changing seasons. Welly Walks. Caring for plants in the growing garden. Observing changes in the pond.

# - Creating with Materials:

Continue to develop confidence with model making, drawing, and painting. Learn skills for using chalk, paint techniques, clay & natural materials.

# - Being Imaginative and Expressive:

Recount stories and sing known nursery rhymes and songs. Perform songs and rhymes.
