

English

We will continue to use Read Write Inc 'Get Writing!' for our reading and writing. This uses RWI books to practice reading and as a stimulus for writing. This allows each group to focus on specific graphemes and skills each week. There are specific 'Book Bag' books to read at home that build on learning from the week.

Maths

We will continue our learning about position and direction. We will then move on to looking at place value in numbers to 100. We will partition these 2-digit numbers, find 1 more and 1 less and compare numbers using the inequality signs $<$ and $>$. The next unit covers money; we will recognise coins and notes and count coins. We will finish the year by learning a little about telling the time, thinking about 'o'clock' and 'half past'.

PE

The children will practise and apply gymnastic shapes and travel, developing control and consistency. They will also practice key PE skills ready for whole school sports activities.

RE

We will explore the question '**Do we need shared special places?**' considering special places we enjoy and comparing them to others.

Design Technology

In DT we will be undertaking a project looking at templates and joining techniques. Our final outcome will be a pirate themed puppet that we can use in our play. To do this we will investigate existing puppets and consider how they are made and used. We will try out some joining techniques and consider which are most useful for our project. We will explore different ways of embellishing fabric by sewing, sticking and use of fabric pens. We will then design and make our own pirate puppet. We will evaluate our learning and our finished product.

Pirates! Summer Term 2 Year 1

Science

We will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which parts of the body are associated with each sense.

Music

We will consolidate learning from throughout the year, revisiting skills and musical activities. We will look at using the Language of Music.

Geography

Using pirates as our springboard, we will use maps to learn the 4 countries of the United Kingdom then discover the 7 continents and 5 oceans of our world. We will use simple compass directions to discuss the locations of places in relation to each other. We will use appropriate vocabulary to identify and discuss physical features such as beaches, cliffs, coasts, seas and valleys. We will look at the routes that the famous pirate 'Blackbeard' took and find out about some of the places where he stopped.

Computing

We will continue to investigate 'digital painting' then look at simple algorithms to programme characters on a screen.
