

English

We will use the Read Write Inc phonics scheme to teach children new sounds each week. We will then use RWI's 'Get Writing!' for reading and writing. The program uses carefully sequenced books to practice reading and as a stimulus for writing. This allows each group to focus on specific phonemes, graphemes and skills each week. These texts are then supplemented by specific reading at home.

Geography

Our topic this half term is 'St Andrew's and me!'. We will get to know our new classroom and routines for Year 1. We will learn about maps, using them to explore our classroom, school, town and make some maps of our own. We will start to use a 'Key' to help decode maps. We will look at the human features of Headington, find out about different types of home and give our opinions.

Year 1 Autumn Term 1 'St Andrew's and me!'

PE

We will learn to use playground equipment safely. We will move within a space in different and controlled ways.

Maths

This term we will focus on place value, counting and representing numbers within 10. We will move on to writing addition and subtraction number sentences.

Art

We will use pencils, crayons and brushes to communicate something about ourselves while learning to use different thicknesses of line by choosing different equipment.

RE

What makes me special?
What do we get out of belonging to different groups and how do we show that we belong?

PSHCE

We will think about school rules, choice and consequence and explore 'Zones of Regulation'.

Science

We will start to look at the seasons. We will think about the weather and identify seasonal changes throughout the year.

Music

We will concentrate on clapping the pulse to a piece of music. We will learn some simple beats.
