### **Personal, Social and Emotional Development**

### Building Relationships:

Getting to know each other, playing with others,

#### - Managing Self:

### Literacy

### - Comprehension:

Retell stories & narratives in their own words. Use new vocabulary learned from stories, poems

# - Reading

Learn one sound for each letter (Read Write Inc Phonics – Set 1). Sound blend simple words, read some simple sentences.

Core Stories: Ruby's Worry" "Goldilocks and the 3 Bears", The Enormous Turnip.

### - Writing

Exploring variety of drawing and writing materials. Write own name with recognisable letters; represent sounds with a letter.

### **Communication and Language**

#### - Speaking

Communicating with adults, & each other in small/class group. Use new vocabulary and comment on what they've heard.

- Listening, Attention and Understanding.

Listen to adult instructions, listening to stories and each other. Listen to new and familiar rhymes, stories and poems. Converse with others.

# **Understanding the World**

#### - Past & Present

Talk about the adults in school and their roles. Learn about the past from The Little Red Hen.

- People, Culture & Communities

Observe & discuss their new school environment using photographs & maps. Begin to learn about different cultural communities represented in our school

#### -The Natural World

Make observations of the natural world, e.g. changing seasons.
