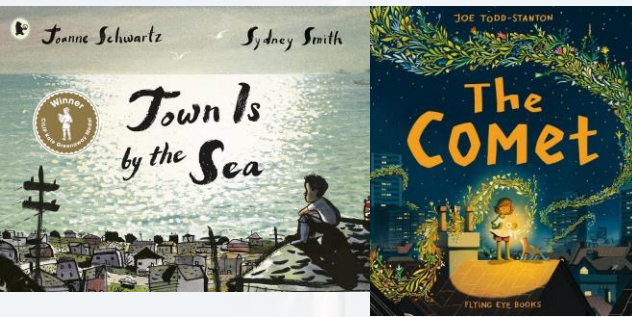


English

We will be studying *The Comet* and *Town is by the Sea* (please don't read them yet!). We will use them as a stimulus for our writing, including poetry, diaries, narratives, pen portraits, and free writing.



Maths

We will be learning about mass and capacity, and time. We will also focus on mental arithmetic in Friday maths lessons.

Music

As in previous terms, we are very fortunate to be having weekly violin lessons.

French

In our French lessons this term, we will learn the days of the week.

Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about fossil fuels and other forms of energy production. We will learn about some of the human issues surrounding these and their physical location and impact.



RE

Our Big Question this term is 'Does Jesus have authority for everyone?'

Computing

We will become familiar with the terms 'text' and 'images' and understand that they can be used to communicate messages. We will use desktop publishing software and consider careful choices of font size, colour and type to edit and improve premade documents.



Science

Excitingly, the children will complete a 'Big Science' investigation. They will plan, carry out and present results of their experiment. Watch this space for an invite to presentations!

PE

In our outdoor PE lessons we will be learning and practising the skills relating to tennis. In our indoor PE lessons, we will develop and apply our reaction and response and floor work balance through focused skill development sessions, healthy competition, cooperative games and Personal Best challenges.



Art & Design

We will have an art focus this term. We will be developing our skills with printing and collage.

PSHCE

We will focus on using our *personal power* to recognise our own feelings, and behaviours. We will learn how to feel safe in different contexts and will discuss the names of different parts of the body, including genitalia, while recapping the PANTS rule.
