This term, we will continue with our text 'Floodland' by Marcus Sedgwick. This is a dystopian narrative which will enable the children to:



- Engage with a story with which they will empathise.
- Explore themes and issues, develop and sustain ideas through discussion.
- Develop creative responses to the text through drama, storytelling and artwork.
- Write in role, to explore and develop empathy for characters.
- Write with confidence for real purposes and audiences.

Topic (Transition) - The Places We'll Go

Much of our curriculum time this term will be spent reflecting on our time at St Andrew's and the lessons we will take with us into secondary school.

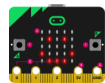
PSHCE

In PSHCE, we will focus on our transition to secondary school. We will have visitors from the MHST in Week 4 to talk to us about transition.

We will also have PSHE lessons where we will work on an entrepreneurial project for the Summer Fair.

Computing

The unit begins with a simple program that allows pupils to build and test their ideas. They will then transfer this work to their micro:bit. Following this, pupils will undertake three new projects, each adding greater depth to their understanding.

RE

In RE our big question is "How can we know God?". We will explore different views of God and how some people believe they can know God or know about God while others do not believe at all. This unit brings together everything we have learned about God, sacred text, symbolism and revelation. It gives pupils an opportunity to explore a range of different ways that people express their beliefs and seek to find answers to some of the big questions of life.



PE

In Week 2, we will be going to Woodlands, taking part in a range of outdoor learning activities, including high ropes, caving and canoeing.



Monday's Outdoor PE lessons this term will focus on badminton. Due to trips and workshops (including electricity workshops and Sports Day), there will only be a couple of Indoor PE lessons—these will focus on athletics.

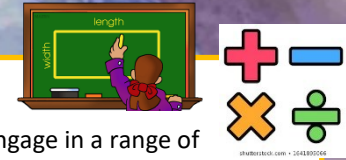
In Week 6, we will take part in the Key Stage 2 Sports Day at Horspath.

Maths

In our Maths lessons we will engage in a range of activities linked to a project titled 'Futures'. We will complete tasks and activities to develop our understanding of wages, hourly rates, bills, mortgages, etc.

We will continue with our Early Work—completing questions in our Mental Arithmetic books—this helps develop our fluency and use of mental maths strategies.

One Doodle Maths assignment will be set each week for homework this term.



Science

This term in Science, we will be studying electricity. As part of this, we will visit the Headington Rye Science Department for a workshop in Week 1, and have a visitor for another workshop in Week 4. We will explore how different components affect simple circuits and investigate what happens when we change elements within the circuit. We will also learn to use scientific symbols and diagrams, and apply our knowledge to design and create a product.

Music and Drama

We will be practising our Y6 play: The Tempest

We will perform our play in Week 6.



French

This term, we will practise our speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills by exploring imaginary holidays to French-speaking countries.
