

English

In English we will be studying 'Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx' by Joe Todd-Stanton. It will act as a springboard for fiction writing from the perspective of different characters, and non-fiction writing around advertisements and letter writing. We will also create our own riddles.



Maths

We will be focusing on mass and capacity, length and perimeter and the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Music

As in previous terms, we are very fortunate to be having weekly violin lessons. We will be working towards a concert for our grown-ups in the final term.

French

Our French lessons this term will focus on Easter. We will be using our newly acquired vocabulary to create French Easter cards.

History

In History, we will continue learning about Ancient Egypt by focussing on the Gift of the Nile, the iconic images of pyramids, the centrally important religious beliefs and the way we can work out details of people's daily lives by interpreting the fragments of evidence that have survived.

RE

Our Big Question this term is 'Does Easter make sense without Passover?' We will also be preparing Year 3's contribution to the Easter Service in April.

Computing

We will develop our understanding of what a branching database is and how to create one. We will use yes/no questions to gain an understanding of what attributes are and how to use them to sort groups of objects. We will create physical and on-screen branching databases.



PE

In our outdoor PE we will be learning and practising the skills relating to tag rugby. In our indoor PE lessons we will develop sending and receiving skills and counter-balance with a partner. We will learn through skill development, cooperative games and personal best challenges.

Art & Design

We will create our own canopic jars using clay by learning about a range of techniques used in clay sculpture.



Science

This term the children will learn what each part of a plant does and learn about different methods of seed dispersal.

PSHCE

We will continue to have a weekly circle time. These will focus on how to recognise our own feelings and how we make sure that we feel safe.
