### Summer Term 1

## Maths

Our focus topics for this term are:

1. Statistics
2. Shape
3. Position and Direction
4. Number: Decimals

We will have lots of opportunities to use manipulatives and draw pictorial representations to help develop our understanding. We will all work on questions that develop our fluency, reasoning and problem-solving.

Early Work will be completing questions in our Mental Arithmetic books, which help develop our fluency and use of mental maths strategies.

Doodle Maths Assignments will be set as part of the homework, linked with that week's learning.

## Geography - Rivers

This term, Year 5 will be studying rivers. This will involve learning about the different physical features that rivers have. We will also be looking at rivers on a local, national and global scale and explore how rivers have shaped human geography. Flooding and its impact, will be a further area for focus for us to learn about.

## RE

The children will explore the Holy Spirit through the Big Question: Are you inspired? They will think about people who inspire them before learning about the happenings at Pentecost. They will research famous Christians to find out what inspired them. They will also develop their understanding of the Holy Trinity.



## Art and Design

We will be learning about different types of sculpture. We will start by looking at existing forms of sculpture, such as the Washed Ashore Project. We will then be learning to plan and create a sculpture that uses recycled materials.

## Music

We will continue to have Brass lessons with Miss Clanchy this term.



## PSHE



We will consider the role of community in our lives. We will be researching and planning opportunities of how we can help our local community.

## PE

In Indoor PE, we will follow Real PE and experience a range of balances and jumps. Our outdoor PE lessons will be focus on developing baseball skills.



**Computing:** Year 5 will be working on creating vector drawings. The children will utilise various drawing tools to craft images.



## Science

This term our topic is Big Science. Over the term the children will plan and carry out different types of scientific enquiry of their choice. They will make predictions, take repeated measurements with scientific equipment, record data and results (using graphs), and interpret that data to draw conclusions. They will present their findings orally to the class and to parent visitors.

## French

We will be looking at how to explain and describe seasons, days, weeks and months.
